Item I.1. Southeastern Louisiana University's request for approval to execute amended and restated leases with University Facilities, Inc. in connection with the conversion of the interest rate on outstanding debt related to student housing and parking facilities from variable to fixed rates.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2004, Southeastern Louisiana University (the "University") embarked on a major renovation of its housing program, which consisted of 1,509 new beds. To finance a portion of the costs of the renovation, the Louisiana Local Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority (the "Issuer") issued \$15,000,000 in Revenue Bonds (Southeastern Louisiana University Student Housing/University Facilities Inc. Project), Series 2004B (the "Series 2004B Bonds") and loaned the proceeds thereof to University Facilities, Inc. ("UFP"), a private non-profit corporation whose purpose is to support and benefit the University. The Bonds were issued with variable interest rates.

With increases in variable rates in the current municipal bond market, the University desires to convert the interest rate on the debt to fixed interest rates. Following the conversion, the Bonds are expected to bear interest at fixed interest rates and the net interest cost of the Bonds is not expected to exceed 5.0%. The Bonds will maintain a maturity date of August 1, 2034.

The University is proposing to enter into an Amended and Restated Ground and Buildings Lease and an Amended and Restated Agreement to Lease with Option to Purchase between the Board and UFI, to amend and restate the existing Facilities Lease and Ground Lease. The Bonds will be secured by and payable from lease payments paid by the Board, on behalf of the University, to the Corporation pursuant to the Facilities Lease, which are derived from the University's housing revenues. The Board and University have not and will not pledge their full faith and credit or State appropriated funds to make any debt service payments on the Refunding Bonds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the following resolution be adopted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System hereby approves Southeastern Louisiana University's request for approval of the form and authorization to execute an Amended and Restated Ground and Buildings Lease Agreement and an Amended and Restated Agreement to Lease with Option to

Purchase, each between the Board, acting on behalf of the University, and University Facilities, Inc., to refinance the Series 2004B Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Southeastern Louisiana University shall obtain final review from UL System staff and legal counsel to the Board, and shall secure all other appropriate approvals from agencies/parties of processes, documents, and administrative requirements prior to execution of documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the President of the University of Louisiana System, and/or the President of Southeastern Louisiana University, and their designees, are hereby authorized and directed to execute the leases described herein and any and all documents necessary in connection with the conversion of the bonds described herein.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System is authorized by Act 293 of the 2017 Regular Session relative to fees charged to students to establish and adjust fee amounts. The legislation includes the authority to impose per credit fees, to impose differential fees for certain programs exclusive of others, and to charge proportional amounts for part-time students and for summer sessions. Each institution will be required to establish a need-based financial assistance fund in an amount not less than five percent of revenues realized by the institution from fees assessed.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Attached is a summary of the financial activities for the year ended June 30, 2018. This information was obtained from fourth quarter financial reports submitted by each university.

This is a report only and no action by the Board is necessary.

Revenues:

The UL System reported year-to-date revenues through the third quarter as follows:

- 1. State General Fund Direct and Statutory Dedicated \$230.5 million 99.8% of the budgeted amount. The universities received 100% of their State General Fund appropriations; however, because the universities received 97.3% of the budgeted SELF funds, the total State General Fund Direct and Statutory Dedicated revenues were 0.2% less than budgeted. The State General Fund Direct revenues increased \$4 million, or 1.9%.
- 2. Self-Generated Funds \$624.5 million or 97.9% of the budgeted amount
- 3. Total revenues reported are \$855 million or 98.4% of the budgeted amount

A comparison of fiscal 2018 to fiscal 2017 self-generated revenues through the fourth quarter follows:

Expenses:

Total expenses for the UL System through the fourth quarter were \$855 million. The UL System reported expenses as of June 30, 2018, as follows:

- 1. Personal services \$598.3 million, 98.6% of the available budget for this category
- 2. Operating services \$85 million, 96.6% of the available budget for this category
- 3. Professional services \$6.8 million, 107.9% of the available budget for this category
- 4. Other charges \$152.5 million, 98% of the available budget for this category
- 5. Acquisitions \$12.4 million, 74.4% of the available budget for this category

System-wide expenses by function as of March 31, 2018 were as follows:

- 1. Instruction, research, and student-related \$621 million, 72.6% of total expenses
- 2. Institutional support \$118.1 million, 13.8% of total expenses
- 3. Operation and maintenance of plant \$83 million, 9.7% of total expenses
- 4. Transfers \$30.8 million, 3.6% of total expenses

Staff Comments:

Revenues

Self-generated revenues through the fourth quarter include tuition and fees for the summer and fall semesters of calendar year 2017, and the spring semester for calendar year 2018 through June 30, 2018.

Total budgeted revenues are up approximately \$21.2 million from 2017.

Universities reporting a decrease in revenues follow:

- 1. Louisiana Tech University (Tech) 1.8% decrease from reductions in nonresident fees
- 2. University of New Orleans (UNO) -5.5% decrease from decreases in state appropriations and nonresident fees

The reductions in nonresident fees are in accordance with Act No. 455 of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature.

Expenses

Expenses through the fourth quarter total \$855 million – 98.4% of the total budget. Total budgeted expenses increased \$21.2 million (2.5%) from 2017. The increase is primarily from increases in salaries and related benefits (pensions and other postemployment benefits – retiree healthcare).

Highlights of Auxiliary Financial Report:

- 1. Year to date revenues and expenses for auxiliary operations, excluding athletics, total \$168 million and \$148.2 million, respectively. These increases represent increases totaling \$9.6 million (6.1%) and \$18.8 million (14.5%) in revenues and expenses, respectively, from 2017.
- 2. As of June 30, 2017, Grambling had taken ownership of its housing facilities from the Black and Gold Foundation. This will be the first year that Grambling has reported all of its housing income in its quarterly reports, which impacts the estimates.
- 3. The decrease in fund balance, after transfers, is \$5.9 million.
- 4. Universities with current year operating deficits in excess of \$50,000 in specific auxiliary operations, before mandatory and non-mandatory transfers, are:
 - a. Grambling \$79,820 for the post office.
 - b. Northwestern \$202,984 for other (rentals and replacements).
 - c. ULL \$5,819,454 for student housing; \$316,707 for the bookstore; \$116,277 for the student union; \$444,754 for the student health center; \$205,842 for the recreation/wellness center.
 - d. ULM \$808,632 for the recreation/wellness center.
 - e. UNO -\$1,260,313 operating loss for the Lakefront Arena.

Athletics

- 1. Total revenues (including mandatory and non-mandatory transfers in of \$49,314,532 million) are \$105,012,041 with expenses totaling \$105,767,866, resulting in an expected current year deficit totaling \$755,825.
- 2. The universities current year surpluses/(deficits), after non-mandatory transfers from auxiliary and operating funds, follow:
 - a. GSU \$531,104 current year deficit; \$11,030,750 fund balance deficit
 - b. Tech \$5,073 current year deficit

- c. McNeese \$9,016 current year deficit
- d. Nicholls breakeven for current year; \$510,966 fund balance deficit
- e. Northwestern \$392,050 current year surplus
- f. Southeastern \$528,856 current year deficit
- g. ULL \$95,000 current year surplus
- h. ULM \$21,174 current year surplus; \$48,907 fund balance deficit

Specified Restricted Funds:

The cumulative ending fund balances for restricted funds totaled \$66.4 million, a decrease of \$2.7 million from June 30, 2017.
