Will Rogers completed his Ph.D. in English at Cornell University in 2014 and is the Tommy and Mary Barham Endowed Professor of English at University of Louisiana Monroe. Rogers is the author of *Writing Old Age and Impairments in Late Medieval England*, published in 2021 by Arc Humanities Press and is currently working on the intersections between trauma and narrative in the *Canterbury Tales*, a project supported by the Louisiana Board of Regents. He currently teaches both medieval and early modern literatures, but offers courses in trauma theory and LGBTQ+ literature. His teaching at ULM has focused on the use of Open Educational Resources (OERs) and how Universal Design can address issues of equity, diversity, and inclusion in the undergraduate and graduate classroom.
