Item J.3. University of Louisiana System's request for approval of payments made by nonprofit organizations to employees of the University of Louisiana System during Fiscal Year 2022 in accordance with provision of Louisiana Revised Statute (R.S.) 17:3390(F).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

R.S. 17:3390(F) provides that any request for payments of over one thousand dollars for any single transaction to, or on behalf of, or to reimburse the expense of a public employee of a public higher education institution or a public employee or officer of a management board of a public higher education institution by a nonprofit organization shall be approved in writing by the appropriate public higher education management board in accordance with written policies and procedures.

In accordance with PPM FB-IV.-6, we are requesting that Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System approve the schedule of payments made by nonprofit organizations to university employees during the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2022. Individual campuses submit quarterly reports of payments that exceed one thousand dollars made by nonprofit organizations to university employees, which have been compiled into the attached schedule.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the following resolution be adopted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System hereby approves the University of Louisiana System's request for approval of payments made by nonprofit organizations to employees of the University of Louisiana System during Fiscal Year 2022 in accordance with provisions of Louisiana Revised Statute (R.S.) 17:3390(F).

Item J.5. Louisiana Tech University's request for approval for a student vote on a new Parking Enhancement Fee.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Louisiana Tech University Student Government Association proposes a referendum for a student vote to create a Parking Enhancement Fee. The proposed fee would be assessed at \$20 per full-time student per quarter, and part-time students will be assessed a prorated amount. A student election is anticipated to be held in Spring 2023. The fee would be assessed for all quarters and would generate approximately \$480,000 annually. The fee would provide funding for construction and improvement of campus parking facilities and for anticipated debt payments associated with the construction. If approved by students, the fee will be assessed beginning with the Fall 2023 quarter.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the following resolution be adopted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System hereby approves Louisiana Tech University's request for a student referendum for a new Parking Enhancement Fee.

In order to accomplish this parking and safety goal, Louisiana Tech University will construct a variety of high-quality parking facilities and spaces, with services and amenities that will help today's students be successful in higher education.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The McNeese State University Student Government Association passed a resolution proposing an increase to the McNeese Recreational Complex Fee from \$30 to \$45 per semester. The increase would be assessed full-time and part-time students for the summer, fall, and spring semesters and would begin in Fall 2023. The student vote would be held April 3-5, 2023.

With the fee increase, the Recreational Complex Fee would generate approximately \$495,000 annually, and the funds would be used to make necessary repairs and provide improved resources to McNeese students.

McNeese Recreational Complex Fee Increase

WHEREAS, the McNeese Recreational Complex, hereinafter "MREC", is one of the distinguished facilities on the McNeese State University main campus. The MREC seeks to provide students with adequate opportunities to improve physical health, mental wellbeing, friendship, and student engagement. It is staffed by Director Lacie Wentzel, one (1) Assistant Director, one (1) Coordinator of Recreation Programs, one (1) graduate assistant, and twenty-six (26) student workers.

WHEREAS, The MREC provides students an opportunity to gain both monetary compensation and valuable work experience through on-campus jobs. They currently employ twenty-six (26) student workers, and have a three-year goal of employing over fifty (50) student workers. The MREC provides these students with free leadership training in the form of conferences and inhouse training. They also provide free lifeguarding lessons and certifications to their student workers who specialize in lifeguarding and aquatic safety.

WHEREAS, The MREC hosts or has hosted several events that are necessary to student engagement, campus operations, and sports development. These events include but are not limited to Cowboy Camp, Nepali Night, Greek Life events, and SLC/SGA student engagement events. Students and organizations have the availability to rent the MREC at no cost to the student or the organization WHEREAS, The MREC also hosts and facilitates Intramurals which are annual sports competitions that students have the liberty to compete at no financial cost to the student. Intramural events the MREC hosts include but are not limited to tennis, softball, football, basketball, volleyball, and soccer. Along with hosting, the MREC also takes the winners of each respective bracket on an all-expenses paid trip to the State Intramural Tournament.

WHEREAS, The MREC had 44,262 unique visits from students to the facilities during normal business hours in the 2021-2022 academic year. The MREC also hosted ninety-three (93) events during the 2021-2022 academic year. Further, the MREC had 814 participants in the wellness programs during the 2021-2022 academic year. The MREC has goals, throughout the next year, to increase participation in each of the subgroups listed above.

WHEREAS, The MREC receives the lowest amount in student accessed fees of any university in the UL System. The assessments that other universities' recreational complexes receive will be as follows: Northwestern State = \$125.5; University of Louisiana at Monroe = \$65; University of Louisiana at Lafayette = \$23.5 (with the addition of \$230,000 in auxiliary fees for the ULL pool); Grambling State University = \$63; Nicholls State University = \$152.25; and University of New Orleans = \$70.

WHEREAS, The MREC has a current annual budget of \$330,000 with their current fee. With this budget, the MREC is unable to provide the best resources to the students of McNeese State University. Along with this, the MREC is also unable to make necessary improvements and repairs to keep the MREC a desirable place for students to spend time at. For the reasons listed above, and to remain completive with other schools in our system, the MREC is respectfully requesting that the \$30 per semester/per student be increased to \$45 per semester/per student. This would increase the MREC budget to \$495,000 yearly, and \$247,500 semesterly.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, The McNeese Recreational Complex requests a fee increase from \$30 to \$45 that shall be collected from all registered students of McNeese State University in the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters of the following academic years. The MREC makes this ask in good faith and with promise that the fee will be used to support the facility and student staff to better provide the students of McNeese State University with student engagement opportunities, physical health improvement, and mental health wellbeing.
