Founded in 1931, the University of Louisiana at Monroe (ULM) is a regional institution with selective admissions, classified as a Doctoral/Professional university. As one of nine universities in the University of Louisiana System, ULM offers 68 degree programs to more than 8,700 students, including traditional, non-traditional, and distance learners. Nestled along the scenic banks of Bayou DeSiard in Northeast Louisiana, ULM provides a dynamic learning environment in the heart of Monroe, Louisiana.

The Board and university are seeking a president with academic and senior administrative success who will be a visionary, entrepreneurial leader; who is committed to fundraising, economic development, and community relations; and who is student-centered. Further, the president should empower others through transparent communication, collaborative management, and shared governance.

Candidates will be expected to have high-level executive experience with demonstrated performance of exceptional quality. Those holding an earned doctorate and having a background in higher education administration are preferred. Management experience in other fields will also be considered.
